Double Take

Following last years successful completion of a major expansion to Walkers Snack Foods 'high bay' warehouse in Leicester the same management and design team have moved on to develop a new 5000m² finished goods warehouse.



The current multi million pound project, now on site at Beaumont Leys and scheduled for completion next year, has been designed by DLG Architects and Ward Cole. This building will provide additional mechanical racking storage facilities within a 23m high integrated external envelope.

Lincolnshire Key Worker Accommodation

Working for Progress Care Housing Association, Ward Cole and PCP Architects are delivering new and refurbished key worker accommodation for United Lincolnshire Hospitals NHS Trust.

The £20million project will provide a total of 454 new homes and improve a further 148 at four of the Trust's county hospital sites by the Spring of 2007. The largest scheme will create over 300 new homes at Boston Pilgrim Hospital, a further 109 new homes will be built and 110 refurbished at Lincoln County Hospital.

Smaller schemes to substantially improve existing accommodation and to increase new housing stock is being designed for Grantham and Louth County Hospitals to provide homes for a wider range of staff groups.

Centre for Biomolecular Sciences

Another high quality project and the third successive design collaboration for the University of Nottingham by Benoy Architects, Ward Cole and M&E consultants Max Fordham LLP.

This is the second phase of the medical research and teaching facility. The building is primarily a steel frame structure extending to four storeys with large stone clad elevations and visible service risers to match the design of the phase one building, designed by the same team and completed in 2003.

Nottingham based building contractors, Thos Fish & Son Limited have recently been awarded a £12.5 million contract schedule for completion in the New Year 2007. The new facilities will then provide research and teaching accommodation, including a 550 seat capacity lecture theatre which will be the largest on the [University Park Campus](#).
