John Port School 'Specialist Technology College'



Topped out in December 2005 the new Edale Building is the first phase to be completed of the Etwall Campus improvements.

Designed by Horsley Huber Architects and built by G F Tomlinson the new building provides teaching accommodation and facilities for the Faculty of Humanities. A range of smaller classrooms provide accommodation for the Faculty of Curriculum Support. In addition there is a medical centre and offices for 'Connections', the careers advice service, education psychologists, Social Services and Health Visitors.

These facilities will enable the John Port School to continue to develop its role as an "Extended School", in line with Government initiative to create better links between education, community and local services.

As part of an ongoing programme of improvements to Monks Road Campus a new reception building has been added to the existing administration facility.

Part new build and part refurbishment, the new building was designed by Lincoln based architects, CAD Associates, engineers Ward Cole and built by Lindum BMS.

Worksop College Expansion

First established in 1890 by Canon Woodward the college campus is dominated by handsome collegiate style buildings surrounded by lawns and gardens, set with a 310 acre estate. Girls were first admitted to the school in 1978 and today number 117 students of which just 34 board.

Our current new build Dormitory project designed by Franklin Ellis Architects and being built by Clegg Construction to provide accommodation for 50 girls.

The traditional style, three storey building under a pitched tile roof will also provide accommodation for the house mistress and a tutor.

Surbiton Girls High School Kingston Upon Thames



A new four storey teaching block has been officially opened by Britain's No. 1 female skier and former pupil, Chemmy Alcott. The celebrations were completed with a dedication service led by the former Archbishop of Canterbury, Lord Carey of Clifton.

The project is another design collaboration between Franklin Ellis Architects and Ward Cole structural designers. The traditional style building under a pitched slate roof provides classroom and administration office accommodation with the addition of an Art Department on the top floor where the structure incorporates a suspended mezzanine floor.
